

Renata Krakaurer was entrusted to a Polish family as a baby... it was her mother that snuck her out of Sosnowiec Ghetto... interested in the role of women and the #Holocaust 1.5M babies and children murdered by Nazis... her survival is truly a miracle #LOC2019





Visited #NewSynagogue in Berlin... built to symbolize Liberal Judaism in the 19th century... destroyed during Kristallnacht in 1938... facade now rebuilt and houses Jewish museum #LOC2019







Visited "Block of Women" memorial to the women's uprising of 1943... women in mixed marriages protested detention of their husbands by SS and Gestapo... eventually released - sculpture by Ingeborg Hunzinger is a monument to the courage of the women #LOC2019






At Tiergartenstrasse 4 - Memorial for the Victims of National Socialist "

Memorial to the Murdered Jews of Europe... design by Peter Eisenmann erected 1999... profoundly moving... #LOC2019





Between 1941 and 1945, 50,000 Jews of Berlin were deported to death camps from Grunewald Station... plaques meticulously record dates, numbers and camps... #LOC2019 #NeverAgain
















Below you can see the remaining walls from the Warsaw Ghetto...450,000 Jews forced to live in the Ghetto, an area of 3.4km... deportations to the death camps began in October 1942 #LOC2019












Warsaw Zoo was next... history captured in The Zookeepers Wife... Dr Jan Zabinski and his wife Antonina who saved 300 Jews from the Warsaw Ghetto - honoured by Yad Vashem as one of the Righteous Among Nations #LOC2019

And most moving today, a visit to the JewishHistorical Institute - on the site of the Great Synagogue with floors scorched but surviving the fires of the Warsaw Ghetto, housing the "Oneg Shabbat" collection - 6000 documents - Ringelblum & others collected in the Ghetto #LOC2019

Treblinka - built for the sole purpose to kill - between July 1942 and Nov 1943 900K Jews of Warsaw Ghetto murdered. Designed to be hidden in the forests... destroyed... 45 minutes from arrival to death... Evidence provided by survivors #NeverForget #LOC2019







Museum established at Treblinka and the site memorialized through monuments and stones - 216 carry names of the cities and towns of the victims #HonourMemory #NeverForget #LOC2019





Visited the small shtetl of Tychocin - 2,000 people prior to August 1941 - beautiful old Synagogue built in the 14th century... hundreds of shtels (small Jewish towns) all over Eastern Europe were thriving prior to Nazi regime #LOC2019



Enroute from Warsaw to Belzec... built by prisoners... killings began March 17, 1942 and ended Dec 1942. Estimated number of deaths is 500-600,000, mainly Jews... stopped by a windmill... notice howitzer guns in the yard #LOC2019























Today #LOC2019... Kazimierz District-spiritual & cultural centre for Polish Jews from 15th century to WWII... In Oct 1939, the Nazis registered 68,482 Jews in Kraków - Podgórze was the site of the former Ghetto... #NeverForget





The Old Synagogue - permanent exhibit exhibition in the main prayer hall is dedicated to an understanding of Judaism... important for understanding #LOC2019











Profoundly moved by testimony from Miroskawa Grusczynska - #RighteousAmongNations whose mother saved 14yr old Miri... When asked why, she responded as a Catholic it was my duty... to save another human life even at the expense of my own #LOC2019


