- A bit about Me: I'm a mom. I have lived in Ward 9 for 25 years. I have 2 kids at a TDSB School in the northern part of the ward. I have a son in grade 6 in a French immersion program and a daughter in grade 3 in an English program. Prior to

becoming a trustee, I was very active at the school level on the School Council, in various community initiatives in Little Jamaica, and also at the School Board. Previously I was the Community Co-Chair of the TDSB's Black Student Achievement Community Advisory Committee (BSACAC), which is a central committee that advises the board on matters of policies and procedures impacting Black students. I also sit on a provincial board called the Ontario Alliance of Black School Educators (ONABSE), as the Chair of the Governance in Education Commission. In that role I work directly with the Ministry of Education on advising the Ministry regarding measures to improve outcomes for Black students and educators. Professionally, I spent 14 years as a strategic account manager for a large science and technology company. And since coming back from my second maternity leave I decided to shift my focus to my family. I had a very, very demanding and time consuming career where I was not seeing my family. Things changed for me when I had a family and I decided to become more involved and active in the school community. Most recently, I've been working as an Equity, Diversity, Inclusion and Antiracism consultant in the public and private sector, and also as a consultant in TDSB schools. I have had to give up my work as a paid consultant with the TDSB in order to become a trustee. But prior to being a trustee I was running antiracism workshops in schools, through school councils, as well as strategic school improvement planning (SIP) workshops with school councils, staff, and administrators. So, I'm familiar with some of the work going on in our schools, and I'm looking forward to continuing to participate in that work in my capacity as Trustee.
