Middle French Immersion Application (Grade 4 entry)

Currently, eligible applicants are born in **2017**, residing in the City of Toronto.

Applications received after the deadline will be marked late. There is **no guarantee** of admission for late applicants.

While admission is currently guaranteed at the entry point to all eligible on-time applicants, admission to a specific school is **NOT** guaranteed.

An online application must be submitted for each child including twins, triplets or multiples. Siblings attending the same program at the same school (not in a graduating year) must be indicated on the application.

Out-of-Area Admissions Process

Applicants may select ONE school for either Regular (English) or French or Remote (VSS)

TDSB students applying for Intensive French in non-entry grades must already be registered/signed up or enrolled in an Intensive French program. Applicants will only be seated if space is available at the requested grade. No transportation

Keep this in mind...

Applicants are seated based on the primary home address of record prior to the application deadline. If the address changes between the application deadline and the fall of the entry year, there is no guarantee of admission in the new area.

Late applicants are held on a local school waitlist subject to available space until the end of September of the initial year (i.e., Grade 4).

There are no waitlists in French Immersion for non-entry grades.
