Knowing who our students are, about their school experiences, relationships in school, physical health and well-being, allows us to make informed and meaningful decisions that support their achievement and wellbeing. More than 220,000 people, including students from Grades 4 to 12 and parents of students in JK to Grade 6, completed the Toronto District School Board census to give us a comprehensive picture of our students. This rich data is one valuable piece of information we use to help inform decisions and respond directly to the voices of students and parents to create learning spaces that are engaging, inclusive, opportunity-driven and support student success.
