Ward 6 Facilities and Collegiate Attendance Areas

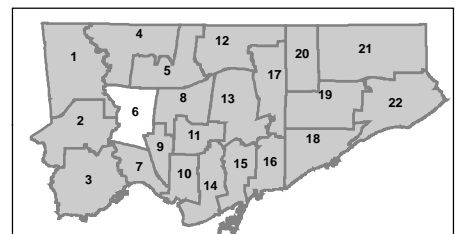

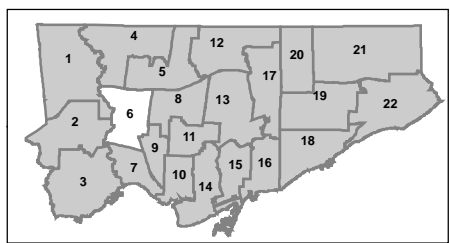

4.8 km Walking Distance from York Memorial CI and Collegiate Attendance Area



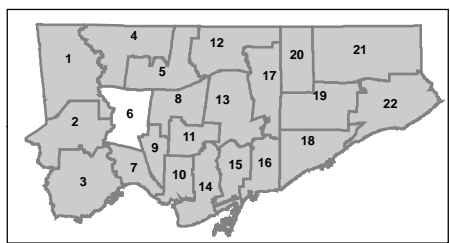
