


## Local Feasibility Team's Recommended Scenario (amended as per PART feedback):

Effective September 2019, the LFT recommends the following:

#### 1. Junior Attendance Area Changes


- A boundary change between Regal Road Jr PS and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA to direct the portion of Regal Road Jr PS' junior attendance area, west of Lansdowne Avenue and south of Davenport Road, to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA;
- A boundary change between Perth Avenue Jr PS and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA to direct the portion of Perth Avenue PS' junior attendance area north of the railway tracks to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA;
- A boundary change between Regal Road Jr PS and Rawlinson CS to direct the portion of Regal Road Jr PS' junior attendance area, north of St. Clair Avenue West, to Rawlinson CS, and
  - Grandparenting of all students who reside in the current Regal Road Jr PS and Perth Avenue Jr PS attendance areas and attend those schools as of the end of the 2018/19 school year, so that they may be allowed to attend their respective school until they graduate.
  - Grandparenting of all siblings of English-track students actively attending Regal Road Jr PS or Perth Avenue Jr PS, so that they may be allowed to attend their respective school until they graduate. (As per TDSB Operational Procedure 597, children with siblings in the French program at Regal Road Jr PS or Perth Avenue Jr PS and who have applied for French Immersion at those schools will have priority placement.)





#### 2. Intermediate Attendance Area Changes


- A boundary change between Winona Drive Sr PS and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA to direct the portion of Winona Drive Sr PS' intermediate attendance area, west of Lansdowne Avenue and south of Davenport Road, to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA;
- A boundary change between Brock PS and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA to direct the portion of Brock PS' intermediate attendance area north of the railway tracks to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA;
- A boundary change between Winona Drive Sr PS and Rawlinson CS to direct the portion of Winona Drive Sr PS' intermediate attendance area, north of St. Clair Avenue West, to Rawlinson CS, and
- A boundary change between Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA and Rawlinson CS to direct the portion of Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA's intermediate attendance area, north of St. Clair Avenue West, to Rawlinson CS.
  - Grandparenting of all students who reside in the current Winona Drive Sr PS, Brock PS, and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA intermediate attendance areas and attend those schools as of the end of the 2018/19 school year, so that they may be allowed to attend their respective schools until they graduate, and
  - Grandparenting of the following junior to intermediate school pathways up to (and including) the 2026/2027 school year for students who attend the respective junior school as of the end of the 2018/19 school year:
    - Regal Road Jr PS to Winona Drive Sr PS;
    - Regal Road Jr PS to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA;
    - Perth Avenue Jr PS to Brock PS.





### 3. Program Changes

• The future relocation of the Section 23 and Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (FASD) program from Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA in 2022 (or at a time when enrolment growth requires that additional classroom space be made available at the school). A separate review will be undertaken with Section 23 staff, planning staff, and the local Superintendent to find a suitable site for the Section 23/FASD program.





## **Community Feedback**

Proposed junior and intermediate attendance area boundary changes

- There are still concerns with respect to the utilization at Regal Road Jr PS and Winona Drive Jr PS with the proposed boundary changes in place.
- Proposed boundary change between Regal Road Jr PS and Rawlinson CS not necessary given the numbers.
- Glad that cohort at Regal Road Jr PS will be allowed to stay together when they transition to Grade 7.
- How many siblings might there be in the Perth Avenue Jr PS boundary change area?

## Proposed program relocation

- Will parents be involved in discussions regarding the possible relocation of the Section 23/FASD program?
- Where do the Section 23/FASD students live?

#### Other comments

- How will increased enrolment at Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA translate into need for more staff, breakout space, and/or amenity space?
- Will more VPs be hired at Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA?
- Have staff considered using Earlscourt property to address accommodation pressures?
- Have schools to the north been considered as part of the accommodation solution?
- Can Winona Drive Sr PS become a Grade 6-8 school?
- Can house next to Regal Road Jr PS be purchased?
- Given that enrolment is declining at St. Luigi, can TDSB take back more space from TCDSB?



#### Program Area Review Team's Recommendation (REVISED – May 4, 2018)

It is recommended that:

- 1. The portion of Regal Road Jr PS' attendance area, west of Lansdowne Avenue (including the west side of Lansdowne Avenue) and south of Davenport Road, be directed to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA effective September 2019.
- 2. The portion of Perth Avenue Jr PS' attendance area, north of the railway tracks, be directed to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA effective September 2019.
- 3. The portion of Regal Road Jr PS' attendance area, north of St. Clair Avenue West (including the north side of St. Clair Avenue West), be directed to Rawlinson CS effective September 2019.
- 4. The portion of Winona Drive Sr PS' attendance area, west of Lansdowne Avenue (including the west side of Lansdowne Avenue) and south of Davenport Road, be directed to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA effective September 2019.
- 5. The portion of Brock PS' intermediate attendance area, north of the railway tracks, be directed to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA effective September 2019.
- 6. The portion of Winona Drive Sr PS' attendance area, north of St. Clair Avenue West (including the north side of St. Clair Avenue West), be directed to Rawlinson CS effective September 2019.
- 7. The portion of Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA's intermediate attendance area, north of St. Clair Avenue West (including the north side of St. Clair Avenue West) and east of Prospect Cemetery, be directed to Rawlinson CS effective September 2019.
- 8. All students who reside in the current Regal Road Jr PS, Perth Avenue Jr PS, Winona Drive Sr PS, Brock PS, and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA attendance areas and attend those schools as of the end of the 2018/19 school year be allowed to remain at Regal Road Jr PS, Perth Avenue Jr PS, Winona Drive Sr PS, Brock PS, and Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA until they graduate.
- 9. All siblings of English-track students actively attending Regal Road Jr PS or Perth Avenue Jr PS be allowed to attend their respective school until they graduate.
- 10. The following junior to intermediate school pathways up to (and including) the 2026/27 school year be grandparented for students who attend the respective junior school as of the end of the 2018/19 school year:
  - Regal Road Jr PS to Winona Drive Sr PS;
  - Regal Road Jr PS to Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA;
  - Perth Avenue Jr PS to Brock PS.
- 11. The Section 23 and Fetal Alcohol Syndrome (FASD) program be relocated from Carleton Village Jr & Sr SWA in 2022 (or at a time when enrolment growth requires that additional classroom space be made available at the school). A separate review will be undertaken with Section 23 staff, planning staff, and the local Superintendent to find a suitable site for the Section 23/FASD program.
- 12. Staff bring forward a request to retrofit Lunchroom 3 at Regal Road Jr PS for September 2018 in order to address the projected shortage of one classroom space.



## **Program Area Review Process**

### **Role of the PART:**

- Advisory role
- The PART shall make recommendations to inform staff and Board
- PART recommendation(s) may be modified by staff and/or Board members

## **Functioning of the PART:**

- The PART shall function by reaching consensus among members
- If consensus cannot be reached, a vote shall occur
- Voting members: Principals and School Council Chairs
- PART to define quorum, voting procedure, and process to be followed in the event of tie vote



## **Next Steps...**

- Program Area Review Team submits report summarizing recommendations to Central Accommodation Team (CAT) – May 2018
- Report outlining staff recommendations scheduled to be brought forth for Board approval on June 20, 2018
  - PART report will be appended to staff report
- There will be opportunity for the public to depute at the Planning & Priorities Committee, held a week prior to the regular Board meeting (June 13<sup>th</sup>)
- If staff recommendations are approved by the Board of Trustees, Superintendent and affected Principals will notify staff and students and proceed with addressing details regarding the transition.
