

Setting the Context: Why are we here?

- Secord ES is overutilized and continues to experience accommodation pressures.
- Secord ES has a total of 27 classrooms plus a large portapack on site providing 12 additional classrooms.
- In September 2023, Secord ES came in over projection by approximately 60 students. An additional standalone portable was added to the site in October to accommodate the additional growth.
- Enrolment is projected to continue to grow over the long-term. New residential development is a contributing factor, along with newcomer enrolment.
- A business case has been submitted to the Ministry of Education to support the need to build a new, larger replacement Secord school, to accommodate future enrolment growth in the area (long term solution).
- A feasible and sustainable solution is required to address accommodation pressures at the school in the interim.




Redirection of new residential development

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



*<u>Students who live at the above addresses and currently attend Secord ES</u> and DA Morrison will not be affected *




Proposed Attendance Boundary Change Map






DA Morrison- Boundary Change Model



Boundary Change Enrolment Projection – Crescent Town ES




Crescent Town ES- Boundary Change Model

- Surplus of four (+4) rooms 2025 onwards
- Between 72-74% utilization in the long-term



George Webster ES - Boundary Change Model

George Webster ES Outcomes:

- Increased utilization with 43 of 45 rooms in use
- Surplus of two (+2) rooms 2024 onwards
- Between 90-94% utilization in the long-term

Other Considerations

- The associated Early French Immersion program for the impacted area would change from Secord ES/DA Morrison MS to Clairlea PS.
 - No impact on Secondary (East York CI) pathway.
- The associated school to access Middle French Immersion, beginning in Grade 4, will be Cliffside PS.
- Boundary change would be phased in: The Local Feasibility Team is proposing that all students who reside in the impacted area be allowed to continue to attend Secord ES/DA Morrison MS (no students will be asked to move).
- Also , the Local Feasibility Team is proposing that siblings of current students residing in the impacted areas be allowed to register and attend Secord ES/DA Morrison MS until graduation.
- There is no impact on transportation as the impacted area is within walking distance to both Secord ES and Crescent Town ES
- Both Secord ES and Crescent Town ES offer a Before and After school Program on-site.



Staff Proposed Recommendations

Attendance Boundary Change

a) That the junior attendance area for Crescent Town ES (JK- Gr 4) and intermediate attendance area for George Webster ES (Gr 5 -8) be expanded to include the portion of the Secord ES junior attendance area south of Crescent Town Road to **100,102,104**,

106,108 Goodwood Park Court, effective June 30, 2024 (Regular Program) and June 30, 2025 (French Immersion program);

b) That all students who reside in the portion of the Secord ES attendance areas described in this recommendation and attend Secord ES (JK -Gr 5) and DA Morrison MS (Gr 6-8) as of June 30, 2024, <u>along with their siblings</u>, may choose to attend Secord ES and DA Morrison MS until they graduate.
