


- The LTPAS advances the system goal to "provide equity of access to learning opportunities for all students"




Setting the Context: Why are we here?

- TDSB's Long-Term Program and Accommodation Strategy (LTPAS) outlines several guiding principles:
 - **Consistent attendance boundaries** establish consistent attendance boundaries across the TDSB by reviewing instances of shared boundaries where multiple schools serve students based on home addresses and split attendance boundaries that separate graduating cohorts among multiple schools.
 - **Optimal utilization rate of 90%** Ensure that school buildings are used efficiently by targeting utilization rates of 90% while recognizing the importance of child care address issues of... overutilization (schools operating at 110% utilization or greater) use existing space in schools efficiently to balance enrolments.
- The purpose of this boundary change is to:
 - 1. Eliminate the shared attendance areas between Northern SS, Lawrence Park CI, York Mills CI, and Leaside HS.
 - 2. Address accommodation pressures at North Toronto Cl.

















- This will be effective following Board approval,
- More than 65 residential projects,
- Approximately 28,000 units,
- All future residential developments will also be redirected.




Boundary Change Enrolment Projection – Lawrence Park Cl



Lawrence Park CI Outcomes:

- Increase of approximately 2% utilization over time.
- Approximately 16 to 19 additional secondary students from Northern SS and York Mills CI.
- Eliminates shared attendance boundaries with Northern SS for consistent secondary attendance boundaries.

Boundary Change Enrolment Projection – Leaside HS




Leaside HS Outcomes:

- Decrease of approximately 2% utilization over time.
- Approximately 11 to 16 less secondary students. These would be directed to Northern SS.
- Eliminates shared attendance boundaries for consistent secondary attendance boundaries.



Boundary Change Enrolment Projection – York Mills Cl



York Mills CI Outcomes:

- Increase of approximately 0.2% utilization over time.
- Approximately 2 to 3 additional secondary students from Northern SS.
- Eliminates shared attendance boundaries for consistent secondary attendance boundaries.



Boundary Change Enrolment Projection – North Toronto Cl




North Toronto CI Outcomes:

- Decrease of approximately 42% utilization over time.
- Approximately 500 secondary students would be directed to Northern SS.



Boundary Change Review-Public Meeting

Boundary Change Enrolment Projection – Northern SS



Northern SS Outcomes:

- No change in utilization.
- Net increase of approximately 140 in-area students per year.
- Northern will still be able to accommodate about 130 students through SSWAB (secondary school without a boundary) applications each year.
- Eliminates shared attendance boundaries for consistent secondary attendance boundaries.

That the shared secondary attendance area between Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute and Northern Secondary School be directed entirely to Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute, effective September 1, 2026 (Regular Program).



b) That the shared secondary attendance area between Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute, York Mills Collegiate Institute, and Northern Secondary School be directed entirely to Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute, effective September 1, 2026 (Regular Program).



c) That the shared secondary attendance area between Leaside High School and Northern Secondary School be directed entirely to Northern Secondary School, effective September 1, 2026 (Regular Program).



d) That the shared secondary attendance area between York Mills Collegiate Institute and Northern Secondary School that also falls within the Armour Heights Public School intermediate boundary be directed to York Mills Collegiate Institute, effective September 1, 2026 (Regular Program).



e) That the shared secondary attendance area between York Mills Collegiate Institute and Northern Secondary School that also falls within the Bedford Park Public School and Glenview Senior Public School intermediate boundaries be directed to Northern Secondary School, effective September 1, 2026 (Regular Program).



Staff Proposed Recommendations

Attendance Boundary Change

- f) That the following portions of the **North Toronto Collegiate Institute**'s secondary attendance area be directed to **Northern Secondary School**, effective September 1, 2026 (Regular Program):
 - 1. Block 1: south of Blythwood Rd, east of Mount Pleasant Rd, north of Broadway Ave, west of Mount Hope Cemetery,
 - 2. Block 2: south of Mount Pleasant Cemetery, east of David Balfour Park Trail, north of C.P. Railway, west of Ravine Beltline Trail.



Staff Proposed Recommendations

Attendance Boundary Change (Residential Redirections)

g) That the residential developments* located within the North Toronto Collegiate Institute attendance area, that are yet to be occupied, be directed to **Northern Secondary School**, effective immediately (Regular Program).

Staff Proposed Recommendations Legacy Students

h) That all students attending their respective secondary school (Northern Secondary School, North Toronto Collegiate Institute, York Mills Collegiate Institute, Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute, or Leaside High School) on June 30th, 2026, be permitted to remain at the school until they graduate.



Staff Proposed Recommendations

Legacy Students

i) That siblings of students described in Part h) be allowed to attend the same school (Northern Secondary School, North Toronto Collegiate Institute, York Mills Collegiate Institute, Lawrence Park Collegiate Institute, or Leaside High School), provided their older sibling is currently attending that school at the time the younger sibling enters, and be allowed to remain until they graduate.


